All – At yesterday’s meeting, we agreed YCWA would file with FERC two revised plans on which I believe we have agreement. These are:

- YCWA’s Proposed Condition GS3, *Log Cabin and Our House Diversion Dams and New Bullards Bar Reservoir Large Woody Material Management Plan*
- YCWA’s Proposed Condition RR1, *Recreation Facilities Plan*
