Notice of Project Tour

Thursday, October 1, 2009

PURPOSE

The primary purpose of the Project Tour is to provide interested agencies, Native Americans tribes, and non-governmental organizations (NGOs) with an on-the-ground overview of the Yuba River Development Project facilities and features as Yuba County Water Agency (Licensee) enters relicensing.

This tour should not be confused with the tour that the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) will offer to interested Relicensing Participants after Licensee files its Notice of Intent to File an Application for a New License and Pre-Application Document. The October 1 tour is an informal tour offered by Licensee to interested parties.

Those who participate in the Project Tour are responsible for their own transportation, though Licensee will encourage car pooling to the extent practical from its Marysville Office to Project facilities. Two-wheel drive vehicles will be adequate to access most Project areas.

Those who participate in the Project Tour are responsible for their own beverages and snacks during the tour (Licensee will provide lunch), and should wear appropriate clothes (no open-toed shoes). Special safety gear is not required, but some walking is necessary.

Prior to the tour, participants are encouraged to view the Project Fact Sheet and schematic located on the Yuba River Development Project Relicensing Website (www.ycwa-relicensing.com), under "Project Maps, Schematics and Fact Sheet" on the Quick Launch bar.
